Installation Instruction for Seat Height Lowering Kit

PROCEDURE:

ATTENTION: THE INSTALLATION HAS TO BE MADE BY A SKILLED WORKSHOP!



- 1. Disburden the rear wheel and secure the bike against tipping.
- 2. Remove the shock absorber and demount the spring by using a spring spanner.
- Insert the supplied stroke limiter between rubber stop and counter nut; see Pic. 1

Treat the two screws of the stroke limiter with Loctite (for screw safing)

- 4. Demount the original lever; see Pic. 2
- 5. Press the two needle bearings out by using the supplied pin and bushing and press the bearings into the supplied new lever, then.
- 6. Remount the shock and the new lever.
 Attention: Fasten the fixations tightly only when the bike stands with both wheels on the ground (play!). Take care about the torque values given by the manufacturer!

this segment grind off

- Grind off about 2 mm from the pedestal of the side stand (see Pic.3) so that the end stop comes more up with the effect that the side stand turns more forward.
 - **Important:** Take care that the two end stop surfaces exactly align with each other when the side stand is completely turned out.
- 8. Check the chain tension and the setting of the head light and newly adjust if required.

NOTE:

It is always required to adjust the spring preload and setting of the shock absorber in accordance with the weight load; see operating instruction!
